The Heritage Classic Foundation will name new Scholars from the 2021 graduating class. Seniors in all Beaufort and Jasper County high schools are eligible to apply. Each Scholar will have an opportunity to receive a 4-year grant totaling up to \$16,000 or \$20,000.

Scholarship applications are reviewed on the basis of academic success, community service, essays written by the student and financial need. An interview is required by all finalists.

Since this Scholar program was instituted in 1993, 342 graduating seniors have been named Heritage Scholars. These grants, to a college of the student's choice, have totaled more than \$4.45 million.
